



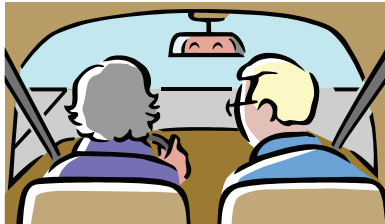
Two singles remain

Passavant offering drive-up service next week

In observance of Colorectal Cancer Awareness Month, Passavant is providing opportunities next week for employees and the community to get a free screening and to hear information from a surgeon about colorectal cancer.

Colorectal cancer is largely preventable, treatable, and beatable through regular screenings, a healthy life-style, and expert clinical care, according to the American Cancer Society. Colorectal cancer afflicts more than 150,000 Americans and kills 53,000 each year.



This Monday, March 22, from 9 to 11 a.m., community members and employees may drive through the circle drive in front of Passavant's Main Lobby to pick up a colo-rectal screening kit. Individuals will complete a brief questionnaire and consent form before receiving the kit. After completing the screening in the privacy of home, individuals mail back the kit to Passavant to learn if they are at risk for colorectal cancer.

Later at 12 noon in Meeting Rooms 2 and 3, John Roth, M.D., a surgeon affiliated with Passavant Surgical Associates, will present "Colorectal Cancer Update." Dr. Roth will talk about colorectal cancer, the screening process, and prevention tips. He'll be available for questions following his presentation.
